

Better access to European LNG terminals

Well-functioning and liquid gas markets are a prerequisite for ensuring affordable energy for consumers, competitiveness of industries, and security of supply. The report „Study on Gas market upgrading and modernisation – Regulatory framework for LNG terminals” prepared in early 2020 by the consortium of Trinomics, Enquidity and REKK identifies and elaborates existing barriers and gaps that could be addressed in order to ensure optimal use of existing LNG terminals in the EU. Frontier and OIES also published their thoughts on the issue in thought provoking excellent papers. Therefore we aim to discuss this question in an expert panel and open it to the audience to foster a good debate. At the online workshop we present the main findings of the reports and discuss with regulators, market participants and researchers how access rules, regulation and services offered at EU regasification terminals can foster better utilization.
